Seminar Descriptions

MOR 1: Ontario Tax Credits & Incentives Available for Corporations: An overview of the harmonized administration of Ontario corporate income tax and a summary of various tax credits and tax incentives which promote economic growth and job creation in Ontario.

MOR 2: Overview of Employer Health Tax (EHT): An overview of how EHT applies to small business, including employer-employee relationships, tax exemption and associated employers. We'll also discuss the Ontario Health Premium.

MOR & MTCU: Overview of Training Options & Ontario Apprenticeship Training Tax Credit: Learn how to access the Employment Ontario programs and services that can best meet your employment and training needs. Includes useful information for employers/employees dealing with downsizing or layoffs. Learn how you can benefit from apprenticeship and training programs and associated tax incentives!

MOL1: Top Employer Issues Under the Employment Standards Act, 2000: Learn about employer minimum standards for hours of work and overtime, vacation and public holidays, leaves of absences (pregnancy, parental, emergency, family medical), termination and severance of employment, and more. Also, learn about the Ministry's investigation and inspection process and the penalties for non-compliance.

MOL2: Pay Equity General Requirements: This presentation will provide a basic overview of employer requirements under the Pay Equity Act, which addresses systemic gender discrimination.

MGS: How to Do Business with the Ontario Government: Supply Chain Management will provide an overview of the competitive procurement of goods and services by the Ontario Government. Our goal is to illustrate how businesses of all sizes and types can be successful vendors through a review of process, policy, effective proposal writing and marketing to the Ontario Government.

ADO: The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disability Act 2005, and the New Accessible Customer Service Standard – What You Need to Know: Did you know that provision of accessible customer service to customers with disabilities is now the law in Ontario? Attend this session to learn what the act (AODA, 2005) means for your business; requirements of the new Accessibility Standards for Customer Service Regulation; and about the resources available to help you comply and improve your customer service for customers with disabilities.

CBO: Government Resources to Help You Start or Grow Your Business: An overview of government programs and services that will assist people to start or grow their business.

CRA 1: CRA – Payroll Information Seminar: The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) will review payroll requirements for deducting, remitting, and reporting amounts for the Canada Pension Plan, Employment Insurance, and income tax.

CRA 2: GST/HST Seminar for New Registrants: The Canada Revenue Agency (CRA) will provide a free seminar to answer your questions on the Goods and services tax/harmonized sales tax (GST/HST) as a new registrant.

CRA 3: Information Seminar for Corporations: Learn more about our services for small business. You will learn about your rights and responsibilities, so that you can take advantage of the tax credits and deductions you are entitled to.

CRA 4: Import and Export Transactions: The application of the GST/HST on imports and exports.

SC: Service Canada – An Overview of Employer Programs & Services including Work-Sharing and ROE Web.

PWGSC: Doing Business with the Government of Canada, Understanding the Process - the Fundamentals: Learn the fundamentals of selling goods/services to the Government of Canada. Acquire information on how to market, how the government does its buying, and how to track opportunities to bid on government purchases.

COEF: First Steps in Exporting: This seminar will introduce you to some of the key tools, resources and services available to the potential exporter. The session will provide an overview of export readiness, preliminary market research, developing an export plan, and knowing your key supporters.
